Giovanni received his PhD in Biomedical Sciences from De Katholieke Universiteit Leuven (KUL), Belgium. A substantial portion of his work as PhD and Postdoc has involved investigating protein—protein interactions (PPIs) and cell death mechanisms in pathophysiology. He then moved to Melbourne to work at the Australian Centre for Blood Diseases (ACBD), affiliated with The Alfred hospital and Monash University. There, he performed extensive drug screens to identify metabolic-based medicine treatments in acute myeloid leukemia (AML). Once back to Belgium, he supported the drug discovery activities of the KUL's Centre for Drug Design and Discovery (CD3), at the crossroad of Academia & Biotech/Pharma. Giovanni's passion for translational/drug-discovery-oriented research spans across different medical fields with a special eye toward Cancer Biology & Pharmacology advances.
