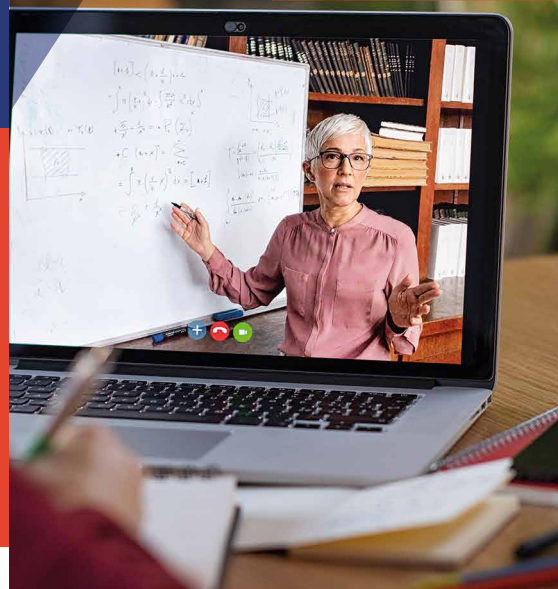

Each day

- a **webinar** with the class to practise the language
- **live workshops** in small groups of 3 or 4 students
- **individual, independent work**
- **intercultural exchanges** with French-speaking students
- **discovering places of interest in our region** through virtual visits: Le Mans, the Loire Valley châteaux, the Le Mans 24 hour motor race...
